PARKING

Cyclist parking can be found across from the Outdoor Pool Complex at 401 Peter Bryce Blvd, Tuscaloosa, AL 35401. Visitor and volunteer parking is in the nearby smaller lot just to the west.

START TIME

All routes will start simultaneously at 7:00 am. It is imperative you are on time as riders will have police escort through campus and the city of Tuscaloosa for rider safety. Please prepare to arrive no later than 6:30 to ensure you are ready to go at 7:00.

POLICE ESCORT

There will be a lead vehicle following police at the start. The pace will be 15-17 mph. For your own safety, please do not attempt to pass the lead vehicle. The Hot Hundred isn't a race, and your safety is our top priority.

PACKET PICK-UP

If you are in Tuscaloosa the night before the ride, you can pick-up your packet between 5:00 pm and 8:00 pm at Black Warrior Brewing. The address is 2216 University Blvd, Tuscaloosa, AL 35401.

Packets can also be picked up on ride day beginning at 5:30 am. If picking up on ride day, you will do so at the start/finish venue.

ROUTE MARKINGS

Routes will be marked inside the city limits with directional signs to keep you on the route.

Outside the city limits, we will be using white spray paint to mark the roads as well as directional signs at important intersections.

We always recommend downloading the routes and using turn-by-turn directions if you have a bike computer that supports this feature.

CUTOFF TIMES

For your own safety, we have created cutoff times for our two longest routes at certain checkpoints. If you havent reached these mile markers by the time below, you will be directed to the shorter distance route.

100 mile route:

12:00 pm at mile 55 - Sand Rd - 11 mph average

116 mile route

12:00 pm at mile 62 - Hwy 140 - 12.4 mph average

Volunteers will be at the above locations to assist you in staying on the correct route.

SAG AND MECHANICAL SUPPORT

We will have support drivers along the route patrolling throughout the day. In addition, our partners at VeloCity Cycles in Tuscaloosa will be providing mechanical support. If you need SAG or mechanical support in any way, please call 205-523-3143
